Interviews and Multiple Mini Interviews (MMIs)

Passing an interview or Multiple Mini Interviews (MMIs) is a requirement for studying medicine - and students on the Progression to Medicine route are guaranteed to be offered an interview at a UK medical school. INTO London will help you prepare with seminars and practice interview sessions.

Work or volunteer experience

Medical schools often require students to have relevant healthcare-related work or volunteer experience - both clinical and non-clinical. We'll help you find opportunities once you start your programme, but you must secure experience in a clinical setting before you join us

University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT)

This is an admissions test used by some universities for their medical programmes. If required by your chosen university, you must take the UCAT before starting at INTO London. Over the summer, INTO London offers a parttime online course to help you prepare to apply for medical school – which includes preparation for the UCAT.

Progression to Health Professions route

As well as medicine, this programme will also prepare you to study a wide range of health-related subjects including nursing, nutrition, optometry and pharmacy.

Students on the Progression to Health Professions route will have a range of university progression options, including:


