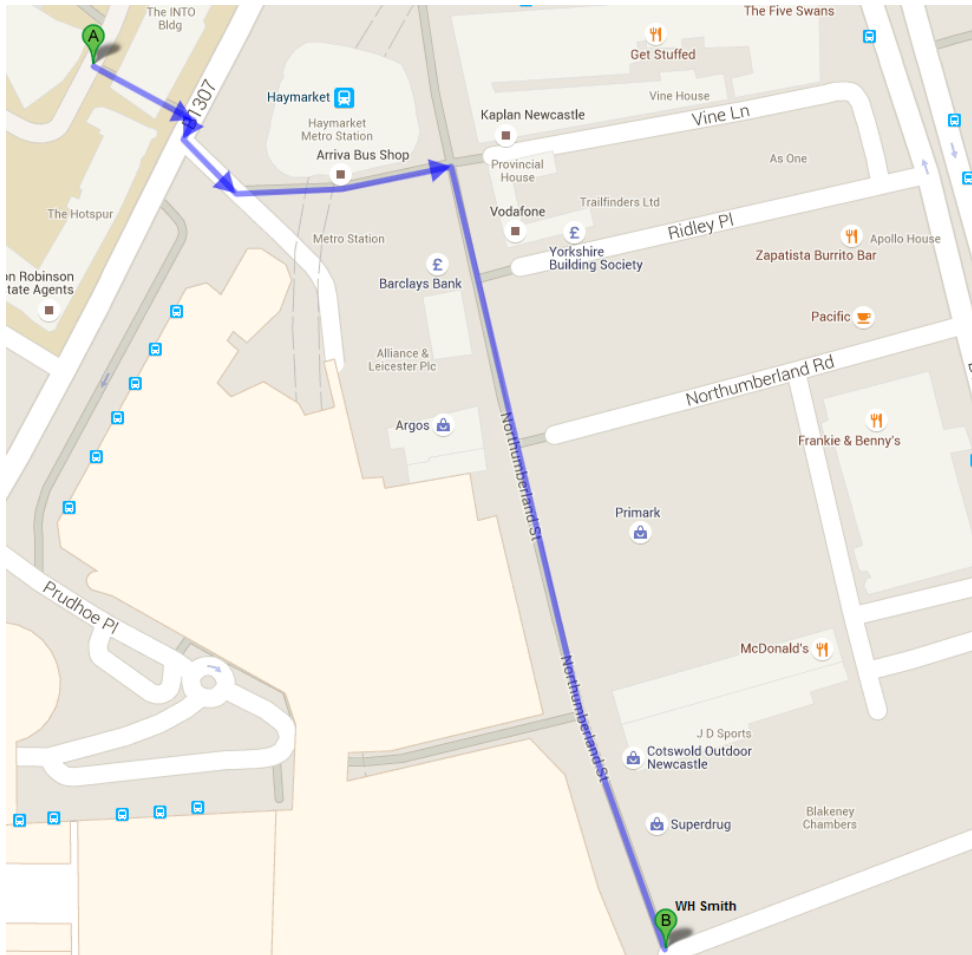
**Barras Bridge Post Office** - 140 Northumberland Street, Newcastle upon Tyne, Tyne and Wear, NE1 7DQ

Northumberland Street Post Office is located within WH Smiths, near the bottom of Northumberland Street.

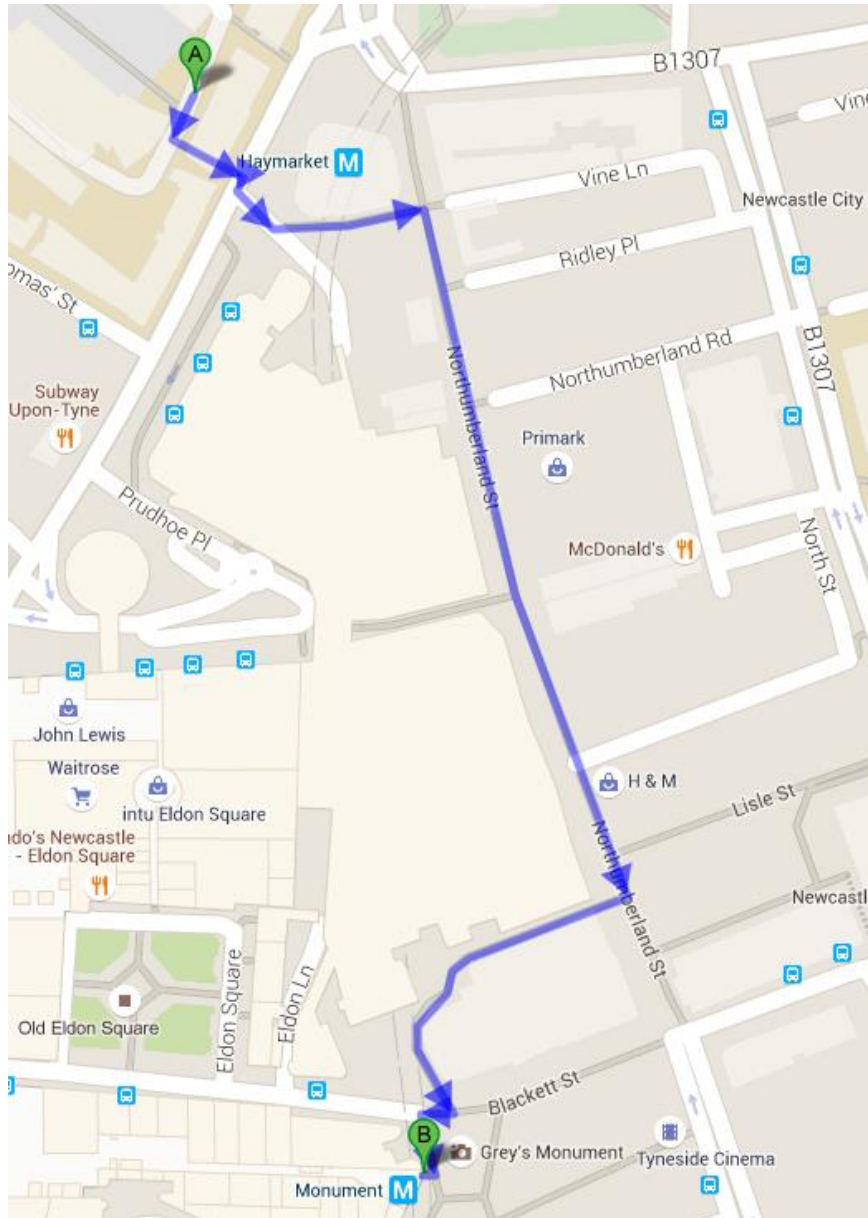


## Byker Post Office

## How to use our Metro station ticket machines

The information banner will help you to choose the correct zones for your journey.



The touch screen is easy to use, just follow the instructions.



Remember to press the 'Buy' button after you have selected your ticket.



Read instructions in six different languages.



Press the audio button if you want to hear instructions.



Your ticket will come out of the machine here.



If you ask for a receipt, or pay by card, your receipt will be printed here.

To buy or renew your season ticket (including Metro Gold Cards) or buy a concessionary child ticket with your Under 16 Pop card, just touch the orange reader with your smartcard.

In the future, this is where you will top up your Pop card with pay as you go credit.



You can pay with coins here.



Pay using payWave here (the contactless method of payment by credit/debit card).



You can pay with debit or credit cards here.



Pay with notes here.



Your change will be dispensed here.



Once you have purchased your ticket go to Platform 3 Metro and board a Metro to "The Coast" and get off the train at Byker (this should take around 4-5 minutes)

The Post Office is only a few minutes walk away.
