US High School	Completion, including achievement of the high school curricular requirements required for freshman admission, including 4 years of non ESL English courses (Grammar, Composition and Literature only).
US University	Completion of 24 or more semester hours of college-level coursework from a regionally or nationally accredited university in the United States, or in any other country in which English is the native language. If English is an official language, but not native, see country specifics below.
